Entering a UNIVERSITY internship

Interns at academic institutions are eligible for complimentary VIN MEMBERSHIP.

Simply provide a university e-mail address (name@school.edu) and your expected program completion date to VIN before your student membership ends.



Entering a PRIVATE PRACTICE internship

If at least one of the veterinarians at the clinic is a paying member of VIN, you are eligible for discounted membership (\$50.00 U.S./program duration) as a private practice intern.

Your mentor must contact VIN and verify your internship and program completion date.



Entering a UNIVERSITY residency

University residents

are eligible for
FREE VIN MEMBERSHIP
by providing a valid
university e-mail address
(name@university.edu),
area of study and
expected program

completion date to VIN.

Entering a PRIVATE PRACTICE residency

Private practice residents are also eligible for complimentary VIN MEMBERSHIP.

Your program advisor or supervisor must contact membership services with confirmation of your residency and its duration.

*If you are the only veterinarian member on VIN at your clinic, New Graduate or regular membership rates will apply based on your graduation date.

To help you transition, your **FREE student VIN membership** continues for three months after the date of your graduation.

All colleagues using VIN must have their own login account. Sharing logins is NOT allowed. Your current VIN account is yours for life. Update your profile today.
